7. **Citizens to Address Council:** (5-minute time limit per signed-in citizen)
8. **Executive Session:** to discuss legal and/or personnel matters
9. **Approve Agenda:** Motion made by Dr. Merritt, seconded by Mrs. Lombardozzi to approve the agenda. Additions noted and recorded. No further discussion, unanimous voice vote, motion carried.
10. **Approve Meeting Meetings:** Motion by Mr. Bills, seconded by Mrs. Lombardozzi to approve the meeting minutes from 2/8/17. No further discussion, unanimous voice vote, motion carried.
11. **Special Business:**
 - a. Motion made by Mrs. Lombardozzi, seconded by Mr. Bello to approve hiring of Garbage employee, Anthony Mankoski at \$9.00/hr. After probationary period increase to \$9.50/hr, because he does have a CDL. No further discussion, unanimous voice vote, motion carried.
 - b. Motion made by Mrs. Lombardozzi, seconded by Mr. Johnson to approve the seasonal hiring of Fred Petrini for Code Enforcement/Zoning. Mr. Petrini will continue at his current rate of pay. No further discussion, unanimous voice vote, motion carried.
12. **Treasurer's Report:**
 - a. Motion made by Mr. Bills, seconded by Mrs. Lombardozzi to approve bills for February 8th, no further discussion, unanimous voice vote, motion carried. Presented bills for 2/22 to 2/24.
13. **New Business:**
 - a. Review quotes for removal of tower on roof top of Borough building. Quote from Mobilcom for the decommission of the communication tower and installation of the antenna to the building totaling \$1,213.34. Rog's Inc. quote for the removal of the antenna is an estimated total of \$4,000.00. Discussion tabled until it will be determined what line time the bills will come out of.
 - b. Discuss the state of fences at Recycling Center and Cemetery – S. Briggs. Mr. Briggs presented pictures of the wooden fence behind the fraternity house on Buffalo Road and the chain link fence around the Recycling Center. Mr. Gross stated that the PWGS employees would repair the wooden fence and that he would obtain quotes for the repair and replace of the fencing at the recycling center.
 - c. Mr. Johnson advised Council of the property next door to the Borough Hall that has been up for purchase and that the Council should look into the purchase price of the property. Ms. McCollum to look into the purchase price.
 - d. Mr. Bello informed Council that Jessica Horan-Kunco from the COG has forwarded an email regarding the application of a grant for multiple municipalities to receive 60-gallon recycling bins to be placed in any of the Borough parks. Discussion as to whether the Borough should participate in. Motion made by Mr. Johnson, seconded by Mr. Bello, no further discussion, unanimous voice vote, motion carried.

 - a. Meeting with Lawrence Park Commissioners – received letter from Commissioners, unable to meet at this time.

- b. Meeting with Harborcreek Township Supervisors - Suggested dates of March 1st at 7:00pm and March 15th at 7:00pm. Ms. McCollum will contact Mr. Pepicello to determine when it will be a convenient time for the Harborcreek Supervisors to meet. This will not be a public meeting and no decisions will be made by either governing body.
 - c. Ms. McCollum presented letter from the Attorney representing the Oster's for the delinquent sewer/garbage account previously reviewed. Mr. Lombardozzi tabled the discussion until Mr. Betza can provide input.
